Re: Measures to assure safe navigation during the peak season of drift-net fishing in the Inland Sea (Request for Cooperation)

Dear Sirs,

The season of drift-net fishing starts from 20th April. Every year, we have implemented safety measures to assure the safety of vessels under our pilotage and fishing boats alike.

Thanks to the cooperation from the vessels, shipping companies and related organizations, there have not been any serious accidents yet.

As you are aware, the drift-nets over 2,000 meters long are used in certain fishing areas. And especially in the area from Bisan Seto to Hiuchi Nada, there becomes particularly crowded with fishing boats in operation of drift-nets, making it difficult for the vessels to assume safe navigation not only inside but also outside the navigation route.

Therefore, we intend to implement the safety measures described on the attached paper, as was done last year, in an effort to assure safe navigation.

Shipowners are requested to settle any claims for drift-nets lodged by the fishermen utilizing the Shipmaster's statement etc. without involving the pilots, as the pilots could not issue any statements concerning damages for the nets during the period of the safety measures implementation.

We thank you for your kind understanding and cooperation and look forward to serving you better in the future.


