Subject: China MSA issued the announcement on carrying out special safety supervision over ships entering Zhejiang waters

Due to the forthcoming 19th Asian Games and 4th Asian Para Games, China MSA will carry out the special safety supervision to those ships which enter waters of Zhejiang province from 16 September to 28 October 2023.

The Announcement sets out various periods and requirements for the domestic and international trading ships respectively with details as follows:

Notice on Carrying out Special Safety Supervision on Ships Entering Zhejiang

Due to the forthcoming 19th Asian Games and the 4th Asian Paralympic Games, in accordance with the *Maritime Traffic Safety Law of the People's Republic of China*, the *Regulations on the Administration of Domestic River Traffic Safety of the People's Republic of China*, and the *Ship Safety Supervision Rules of the People's Republic of China*, special safety supervision on ships entering Zhejiang would be carried out in the near future. Relevant matters are hereby notified as follows:

I. Implementation time and area

1. From 16 September to 8 October 2023, and from 22 October to 28 October 2023, domestic trading ships intend to enter Zhejiang waters for navigation (not applicable for passing by ships), berthing and operation shall conduct special self inspection, special information reporting before leaving the port (form of report is attached).

2. From 16 September to 8 October 2023, ships intend to enter the inland navigable waters of Hangzhou, Huzhou, Shaoxing and Jinhua City for navigation, berthing and operation shall conduct special self inspection, special information reporting, and accept special safety inspection by local maritime administration before leaving the port.

3. From 18 September to 27 September 2023, domestic trading ships intend to enter Ningbo waters for navigation (not applicable for passing by ships), berthing and operation shall conduct special self inspection, special information reporting and accept special safety inspection by the local maritime administration before leaving the port. International trading ships intend to enter Ningbo waters for navigation (not applicable for passing by ships), berthing and operation will be subject to special security inspections by the maritime administration in conjunction with PSC inspection.

4. From 1 October 2023 to 6 October 2023, domestic trading ships intend to enter Wenzhou waters for navigation (not applicable for passing by ships), berthing and operation shall conduct special self inspection, special information reporting before leaving the port and accept specials safety inspection by the local maritime administration. International trading ships that intend to enter Wenzhou waters for navigation (not applicable for passing by ships), berthing and operation shall conduct special security inspections by the maritime administration in conjunction with PSC inspection.

5. From 22 October to 28 October 2023, ships intend to enter Hangzhou inland navigable waters for navigation, berthing and operation are required to conduct

special self inspection, special information reporting, and accept special safety inspection by the local maritime administration before leaving the port.

II. Special information report on ships entering Zhejiang

1. Domestic trading ships intend to enter the waters of Zhejiang shall report ship, cargo and personnel information through "Chuan e Xing" APP (a guidance is attached) before handling ship's departure formalities from the port.

2. If a domestic trading ship changes its port of call after leaving the port and heading to the controlled waters of Zhejiang, it shall submit special information reporting through "Chuan e Xing" APP before entering the controlled waters.

3. Ships that are fixed or permanently navigating, berthing or operating in Zhejiang waters shall conduct the above reporting before 16 September, and shall conduct new reporting if there is any change of ship's information or personnel on board.

III. Special safety inspection for ships entering Zhejiang

1. Domestic trading ships intend to enter the waters of Hangzhou, Ningbo, Wenzhou, Huzhou, Shaoxing, Jinhua shall apply for a special safety inspection to the maritime administration of last port of call to rectify the deficiencies / pass the recheck in accordance with relevant regulations.

2. Fixed or long-term navigating, berthing, and operation in waters of Hangzhou, Ningbo, Wenzhou, Huzhou, Shaoxing, and Jinhua should apply for special safety inspection of ships before 19 September, 2023, to rectify the deficiencies/ pass the recheck in line with relevant regulations.

3. In case any of the following circumstances occurs after conducting special safety inspection, ships shall re-apply for inspection to the maritime administration:

- 1) A general or above level traffic incident occurs;
- 2) Malfunction of major navigational and anti-pollution equipment;
- 3) Change of crew information during this period, or discrepancies found between the reported information and actual situation after inspection.

IV. Special security inspection for ships entering Zhejiang

1. For international trading ships intend to enter Ningbo and Wenzhou waters from a Chinese port, the maritime administration of the last Chinese port shall carry out special security inspection to the ships. For international trading ships intend to enter Ningbo and Wenzhou waters directly from a overseas port, the Ningbo and Wenzhou maritime administration shall carry out special security inspections. 2. Special security inspection on ships include but are not limited to the following items: ship security certificates, security records, continuous summary records, Gangway control measures, control of boarding personnel and baggage items, marking of restricted areas on board and control measures.

3. In case any of the following situations occurs, the ship shall immediately report to local maritime administration and re-conduct a special security inspection:

- 1) A general or above level traffic incident occurs;
- 2) Malfunction of major navigational and anti-pollution equipment;
- 3) Change of crew information during this period, or discrepancies found between the reported information and actual situation after inspection.

V. Other requirements

1. Ships intend to enter Zhejiang waters (not applicable for passing by ships) shall carry out self inspection in accordance with the items listed in the "Special Safety Self-inspection Item List for Ships Entering Zhejiang " (see attached), and correct all the deficiencies before arriving at the port.

2. Shipowners or operators shall ensure their managed ships meet requirements of this notice, report relevant information and be responsible for the completeness and authenticity of the information reported. Ships shall not carry "low, slow and small aircraft" into the above mentioned waters. On the condition that practical difficulties arise in disposing of the aircraft locally as well as there is indeed a necessity to carry it, ships shall declare the type, model and quantities of the aforementioned aircraft when performing the reporting. It is strictly prohibited for ships to use "low, slow and small aircraft" in the above-mentioned waters.

3. Ships shall ensure that the shipborne automatic identification system (AIS) and VHF radio phone (VHF) are kept switched on, relevant information is accurately entered, and are open for communication. If the ship's AIS and/or VHF equipment are not installed according to the requirements or damaged, ships are not allowed to enter Hangzhou, Ningbo, Wenzhou, Huzhou, Shaoxing and Jinhua waters. If the AIS and VHF equipment are damaged after entering above waters, ships shall immediately report to the local maritime administration and follow their supervision instructions.

4.Apart from emergency situation such as protecting the safety of ships and rescue human life, from 23 September to 8 October, and from 22 October to 28 October, ships are not allowed to release the shipborne dinghies (including manned floats, workboats, lifeboat rafts, rescue boats, submersibles, unmanned crafts, etc.) in Hangzhou, Ningbo, Wenzhou, Huzhou, Shaoxing, and Jinhua waters. In case indeed necessary, local maritime administration shall be reported in advance.
